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Admissions Process at Peachtree Academy

1. Complete and return the Application for Admissions:
 - Returning students: Please enclose the non-refundable \$130 registration fee by February 1. If paid after February 1, the non-refundable registration fee is \$175.
 - New Students: Please enclose the non-refundable \$50 Application Fee and \$30 Testing Fee. Please schedule your entrance exam with an administrator if applicable.
 - Upon being notified of acceptance into Peachtree Academy, payment of the \$130 non-refundable registration fee is due. After Feb. 1st registration fee is \$175.
 - Matriculation payments must be paid by March 1.
2. Complete and return the Request for Confidential Records along with your completed application and fees.
3. Send two (2) Teacher Recommendations to applicant's previous school for completion and return to Peachtree Academy.
4. Take the Entrance Exam, if applicable. Tests are administered beginning in January for the upcoming school year.
 - Kindergarten will be tested before being accepted.
 - 1st - 5th Grades (Must reach age 6 by September 1st): Students are required to provide their two most recent standardized test results, current year's report card, two current Teacher Recommendations, copy of student's birth certificate, Certificate of Immunization (Form 3231), Certificate of Eye, Ear and Dental Exam (Form 3300), disciplinary records from their previous school, and conduct an interview with school's administration. Academic testing may be required; including a writing sample.
 - 6th -12th Grades: Students are required to provide their two most recent standardized test results, current year's report card, two current Teacher Recommendations, copy of student's birth certificate, Certificate of Immunization (Form 3231), Certificate of Eye, Ear and Dental Exam (Form 3300), disciplinary records from their previous school and conduct an interview with the school's administration. Academic testing may be required; including a writing sample.

Once your application is accepted and approved by the Administrative Office, you will receive a letter notifying you of your child's acceptance into our private school. You will also receive other pertinent information, in order to secure your child's position within our student body. Peachtree Academy Private School seeks to enroll students with above average capability who are of good moral character. Students are admitted on the basis of academic testing, school records, teacher recommendations, and an interview.

- First preference is given to returning students. Currently enrolled students who do not enroll by February 1st are not guaranteed acceptance for the upcoming school year.
- Preference is given to applicants whose siblings attend Peachtree Academy and satisfy the above criteria.
- Remaining spaces will be filled during open enrollment.

All candidates are carefully considered. No student has the right to re-enrollment. All applications for re-enrollment are approved at the sole discretion of the school's Admissions Board. We strive to make a fair decision based on the services that our school can provide for each child, as well as what the student can contribute to Peachtree Academy Private School. Peachtree Academy Private School admits students without regard to sex, race, color, national or ethnic origin. We set high goals for our students, and we expect them to work hard and strive to reach their potential with the support of their parents/guardians.

If this contract is broken for any other reason, Peachtree Academy reserves the right to demand and collect any legal, collection, or administrative fees which may be incurred.

Classroom concerns should initially be addressed to your child’s teacher. Administrative staff is available by appointment if additional support is needed. A concern that has not been addressed in this manner is not considered a legitimate reason for withdrawing your child and does not release you from your financial obligation.

A returned check fee of \$30.00 will be assessed on all returned checks. All returned checks must be paid in cash.

1. In order to stay connected with my child's school experience I agree to Login to RenWeb (our student/parent information website) at a minimum of 2 times per week for homework, grades and upcoming school events.

Educational Curriculum Guide

Core curriculum

Language Arts

The Language Arts program is designed to introduce children to the love of experience and enhance their love and intrinsic passion for great literature. The phonics-based program in grades K-2 instills the desire to read and ensures reading mastery at an early age. All grades participate in an Accelerated Reader program, which promotes critical thinking and reader comprehension. In each classroom, vocabulary building, grammar, and the mechanics of language are presented as integral parts of the language arts program. Teachers in all disciplines work to promote writing across the curriculum, and pay particular attention to oral and written communication. Students participate in a variety of writing workshops that teach pre-writing, writing, conferencing, revising, and editing to promote proper writing skills.

Math

Peachtree Academy promotes the ideals that children build understanding and develop skills as a result of many meaningful and connected learning experiences. Teachers at Peachtree Academy teach to the national Common Core Standards for Mathematics. These standards define the knowledge and skills students should have within their K-12 education careers so that they will graduate high school able to succeed academic college courses. The standards are aligned with college and work expectations, include rigorous content and application of knowledge through high-order skills, and are informed by other top performing countries, so that all students are prepared to succeed in our global economy and society. Elementary teachers utilize the Math Connects program which is designed to support instruction on the Common Core Standards which will increase student understanding of mathematical concepts at all grade levels.

Science

At Peachtree Academy the science curriculum is a combination of hands-on activities and textbook study. Our activity-based science program encourages students to experiment, observe, analyze, research and discover for themselves the importance of the scientific process. Many methods are used to capture each child's natural interests in science, including laboratory demonstrations, guest speakers, art activities, outdoor observations, written and oral reports, video streaming, computer research and field study. Science laboratory is a major component of both middle and high school science instruction.

Social Studies

In grades Kindergarten through Fifth, the social studies curriculum encompasses a two-part design. Teachers encourage student development through self-awareness and community involvement, as well as an understanding of the historical and world perspectives. Middle and High School curriculum include local, state, national and international studies, from both an historic and contemporary perspective.

In addition to an historical instruction, our Social Studies program includes several community service projects. Peachtree Academy works closely with the Rockdale Emergency Relief and other community organizations that provide goods and services for people in need.

Exploratory Subjects

Art

The study of art begins in kindergarten and continues through the 5th grade through a series of studio projects. Students gain knowledge and learn skills in the materials and processes of art, the components of design, and the variety of forms of expression, as well as an overview of the history of art. This year's art program consists of lessons instructed with the emphasis on cultural art. Various elective courses in Art are offered for students in middle and high school. Peachtree Academy's art program offers several opportunities to participate in various art contests, both local and national, throughout the year. This year's focus is on cultural arts.

Music

Through our music programs, students in grades K-7 are introduced progressively to the components and forms of music, the instruments of an orchestra, highlights of classical music, the opera and famous composers. Students in all grades are trained in singing and choral speaking, and students participate in winter and Spring choral programs each year. Chorus, band and music classes are provided as electives for middle and high school students.

Physical Education

The Physical Education and Athletics Program is essential in educating students about healthy lifestyle choices and developing a life-long habit of physical activity. Students in all grades enjoy 30-45 minutes of physical education daily, whether instructional or playground time, in an age-appropriate, skills-building program. Students are trained in physical fitness through conditioning, movement, manipulative skills, and game skills. Physical Education and Health classes are part of the middle/high school course requirements.

Foreign Language

Peachtree Academy teaches each child, Pre-K through 5th grade, Spanish in the classroom with a curriculum called Hands on Spanish. Spanish is offered as a required elective for 6 – 8th grade students. High School students are required to complete two consecutive years of a foreign language to meet graduation requirements. Additionally, we have added Mandarin Chinese to the list of academic opportunities for students interested in furthering their world perspective through language development and cultural awareness.

Chapel

Our weekly Chapel service is an opportunity to glorify God through praise songs, student scripture skits and a Bible or character building lesson for the week. The students enjoy the time spent singing songs of worship and interacting with peers and faculty. Our Chapel service also includes bi-weekly guest speakers from the community that include ministers, youth leaders, motivational speakers, and other notable guests. Community service, famous people of character, manners, etiquette, and team building are some of the themes that are incorporated into discussions in weekly Chapel sessions.
